***Also in your child's binder the sight words list will be colored green if your child knows that word. If the word is not colored they do not know

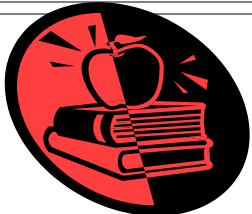


Attendance!!!
