**Also in your child's binder the sight words list will be colored green if your child knows that word. If the word is not colored they do not know that word and should practice

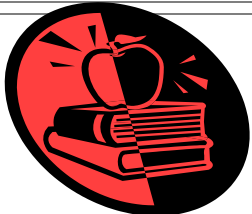


Attendance!!!
